About our school

Viking International School is an international community of learners, families, and educators. Our diversity of cultures, religions, and worldviews helps us to celebrate, learn, and become global citizens committed to making a brighter future for all.

Our learners are excited to ask questions, experiment, and find answers in our inquiry-based learning classrooms.
